CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

You are invited to submit abstracts to be displayed as posters at the Biostatistics Research Day. The aim of the poster session is to provide a platform for the participants to showcase their innovative research, statistical idea or an application in the field of biostatistics and statistics. Students and post-doctoral fellows are particularly encouraged to participate, and are eligible for poster awards, which will be announced at the closing ceremony. Please follow the instructions for poster presentations.

Abstracts (maximum of 250 words, in word) must be submitted online via <u>Call for Abstracts</u> by **June 4th**, **2018**. Please provide the following information: name, email address and phone number; for students, please also state your degree program and university. Please follow the instructions for poster presentations; for details, please see 'Poster Presentation Instructors.' Questions can be directed to biostat.dlsph@utoronto.ca.

Creating a Poster:

Each presenter will have a net useable space in portrait/vertical format that measures **6 feet wide x 3 feet high** in which to exhibit their poster.

The boards will be numbered, and each presenter will be assigned a spot.

Posters should be set up between 8:00am and 9:00am on Friday, June 15, 2018, and remain on display for the duration of the research day until 3:30pm.

Poster mounting supplies (Velcro strips) will be supplied on site by a volunteer. Staples, pins, and double-sided tape may not be used.

You may also wish to bring along copies of your summary or abstract to distribute (be sure to include your complete mailing address and email if you wish additional comments).

Presenters should be available at their poster between 1:00pm and 2:00pm to meet viewers and talk with judges.

Paul Corey Award:

All interested participants are encouraged to submit an abstract for the poster presentation session, and all students and postdocs are eligible for the poster presentation awards. This award is established in recognition of Prof. Corey and will be given to three winners, who will receive certificates and prizes (\$).
