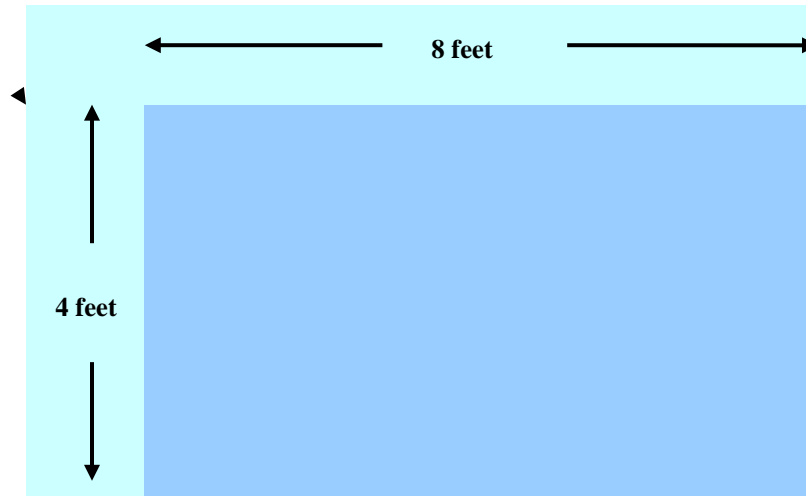


Guide for Poster Presentations

A poster presentation is a graphically oriented summary of your research project.

Each presenter will have a net useable space in portrait/vertical format that measures 8 feet wide x 4 feet high in which to exhibit their poster.



- The poster boards will be numbered and each presenter will be assigned to a board. Please check the poster board list at the reception desk when you pick up your name tag in the 6th floor Auditorium lounge of the Health Sciences Building (HSB).
- Posters should be set up between 8:00am and 9:00am on Friday, June 15, 2018, and remain on display for the duration of the research day.
- Poster mounting supplies will be provided, and you are not permitted to use any other materials than those provided.
- You may also wish to bring along 20 copies of your summary or abstract to distribute (be sure to include your complete mailing address and email if you wish additional comments).
- Presenters should be available at their poster between 1:00pm and 2:00pm (time to be confirmed) to meet viewers, and talk with judges (if applicable, for students and post-docs).
